Their intern, GEORGIE, is obsessed with meteorites. [\(#03 Hicksville Rocks \)](#).

Adam stumbles on a bizarre meteorite that fries electronics and won't budge.

Enter MAJOR DON, a military-intelligence officer with export permits. He reveals he's been diverting Mexican Pentagon funds to support them, and now an audit looms. They must find – or fake – meteorite DNA fast, or the shop's done. [\(#04 Spice It Up! \)](#)

Adam gazes at the night sky, awestruck by its vast beauty and seeming cold indifference to humanity. [\(#05 Little Star \)](#)

That night, [\(#06 Visitation Zero \)](#) AURIGA, an interdimensional medic from the future, visits Adam [\(#07 The Eyes \)](#) The meteorite jams her “fazer” device, and Adam accidentally zaps her back. Under its spell, they soar on a cosmic, out-of-body joyride. [\(#08 Clear Sky \)](#) Come morning, Auriga plays it cool. [\(#09 A New You Tomorrow \)](#)

The shop crew hunts for life in meteorites. Don clocks Adam acting lovesick. [\(#10 Don't Look Down \)](#)

Adam's aunt, THERESA, calls DOCTOR RUCCOLA to hypnotize him. [\(#11 Mystery Box \)](#)

He recounts his starry night and envisions Auriga's reaction. [\(#12 Why Did You? \)](#)

The doc scoffs, but Theresa's all in. [\(#13 Infinite \)](#)

A strand of Auriga's hair shows tweaked human DNA—she's a time traveler! [\(#14 Wow! \)](#) discovery!

On a spaceship, natural humans are extinct, replaced by loveless clone descendants. Auriga's team, led by brash REX [\(#16 The Man \)](#) hunts historic DNA to fix their fertility crisis. Rex's sloppy time-traveling has trashed most eras. Auriga confesses her Adam encounter. Rex wants to probe the old-school way. [\(#17 Visitation One \)](#) storm Adam's room [\(#18 Alien Love \)](#). Rex fazes everyone and tries to abduct them. [\(#19 Get on the One \)](#) Don swoops in, cuffing Rex.

Auriga grabs the fazer to fix the mess, but Adam stops her, spilling about the hair and his love. As time unravels, she whisks him to the Mothership to snag the hair pre-discovery. His presence sparks a paradox, threatening the ship. [\(#20 Storm in a Spaceship \)](#) Adam ejects himself into space. [\(#21 Midnight Lake \)](#) GAIA, the Earth goddess, saves him, revealing a chilling vision of humanity's fate. [\(#22 Come Back in Time \)](#) Using nearby special rocks, Adam signals Auriga, who rescues him. [\(#23 Mothership \)](#) They free a reformed Rex [\(#24 Old Enough \)](#) and hand Don a rock sample.

To save history, Adam and Auriga undo their original meeting. [\(#25 Visitation Zero Reprise \)](#) On the winter solstice, Adam lands back home. [\(#26 Blessed \)](#) Auriga's team swings by one last time [\(#27 Ding Dong! \)](#)—she's pregnant, bearing Adam's DNA to revive future generations, assuring him he'll come to terms with it, while Georgie points him toward local romance.
